

Approved Uses:

- School facility repairs and improvements that reduce the risk of virus transmission.
- Inspection, tests, maintenance, repair, replacement and upgrade projects to improve indoor air quality.
- Other activities that are necessary to maintain the operation of and continuity of services.
- Activities authorized by the ESEA of 1965.
- Coordination of agencies to improve prevention, preparedness and response to coronavirus.
- Provide Principals and other school leaders with resources to address the needs of their individual schools.
- Activities to address the unique needs of racial and ethnic minorities, disabled, or lowincome children or students.
- Develop procedures to improve preparedness and response efforts.
- Train staff on sanitation and minimizing the spread of infectious diseases.
- Purchase supplies to sanitize and clean the facilities and buildings.
- Plan, coordinate and implement activities for long-term closures.
- Purchase educational technology for students.
- Provide mental health services and support.
- Plan and implement activities related to summer learning and after school programs.
- Address learning loss among students.
